

Dear Parents,

During the summer, students can lose as much as 22% of what they learned in reading class by not putting it into practice. That means 2 months of school down the drain!

You can help prevent this summer reading loss simply by encouraging your child to read over the summer. I am sending home a fun reading passport activity. Encourage your child to earn reading badges, or passport stamps, by completing the tasks on each badge. To earn the badge, your child should read for at least 15 minutes.

Feel free to complete some of the challenges together and even create your own reading challenges!

The challenges are divided into six different categories:

- "Who" challenges encourage your child to read with family members, friends, pets, and even stuffed animals.
- "What" challenges encourage your child to read a variety of reading materials.
- "When" challenges encourage your child to read at various times.
- "Where" challenges encourage your child to read in different places.
- "Why" challenges encourage your child to read for different reasons.
- "How" challenges encourage your child to read in different ways.

My goal is for this activity to be flexible, fun, and something that families can participate in together.






