Please return your Book Report for sharing during the first week of school.

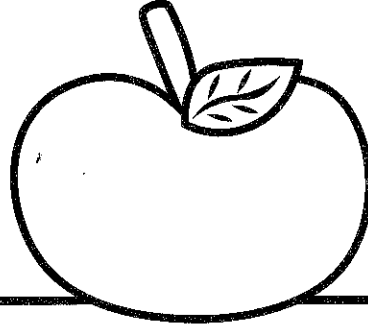

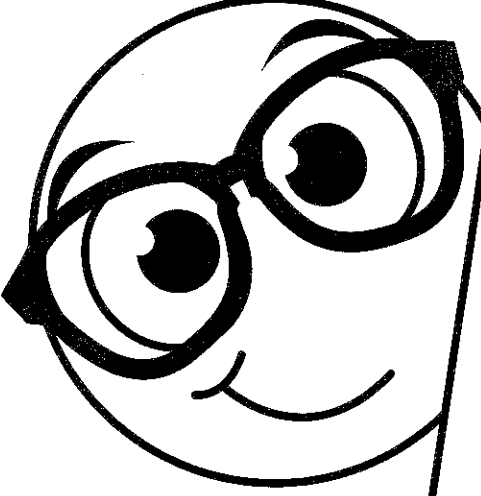

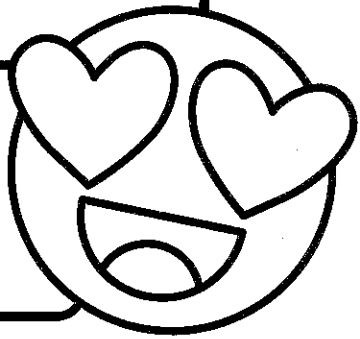
